# GMAT Verbal Reasoning

This section contains questions on **Reading Comprehension and Critical Reasoning**. Here's a further breakdown of the topics tested in the Verbal section-

## Critical Reasoning (CR)

Questions are based on short passages (usually 100 words or less). You are asked to choose an answer that either weakens, strengthens or evaluates an argument. CR assesses your ability to analyse/construct arguments and evaluate/develop action plans. No specialised topic knowledge is needed for this part; you can easily ace it through regular practice.

## Reading Comprehension (RC)

Reading Comprehension questions assess your reading skills to: identify main and supporting ideas, draw inferences, apply information, analyse style and understand logical structure. Remember, Reading Comprehension is not testing you on speed reading, rather, it's evaluating your ability to interpret the text and understand the logical connections among key points.

# GMAT Quantitative Reasoning

This section assesses your problem solving skills through questions based on **Arithmetic and Algebra**. Here's a further breakdown of the topics tested in the Quantitative Reasoning-

## Arithmetic

Multiples and Factors, Number Properties, Fractions, Decimals, Percentage, Power and Roots, Average, Probability, Set Theory, Mixtures and Allegations, Ratio and Proportion, Descriptive, Statistics, Pipes, Cisterns, Work Time, Speed, Time, Distance, Simple and Compounded Interest

## Algebra

Monomials, Polynomials, Functions, Exponents, Quadratic Equations, Inequalities and Basic, Statistics, Algebraic Expressions and Equations, Permutation and Combination, Progressions

# GMAT Data Insights

Data Insights section aims to assess a candidate's data analysis skills through examination of complex data and draw meaningful insights thereupon. You are allowed to use an on-screen calculator for this section.

**DI section focuses on 5 types of questions-**

1. Data Sufficiency
2. Graphics Interpretation
3. Table Analysis
4. Two-Part Analysis
5. Multi-Source Reasoning
