GRE STUDY PLAN (VERBAL) CHECKLIST



STEP 1 Learn the Basics

- Understand the nature and pattern of the GRE Exam
- Learn the Approach to different types of questions: Text completion, Sentence Equivalence, Reading comprehension, and Critical Reasoning
- Learn Tips and Strategies for the AWA Issue section
- Utilize Jamboree's Vocabulary App "Simplified GRE" for Vocabulary building: Learn, Revise, and Quiz

STEP 2 Progress to Mastering Nuanced Techniques

- Practice the basic approach on easy and medium questions
- Understand and Learn approaches to different subtypes of questions in Reading Comprehension
- Take a Timed Verbal Test to check progress
- Download and study ETS' AWA Pool for Issue topics
- Write and review a few AWA essays
- Use Jamboree's Vocabulary App for Vocabulary building: Learn, Revise, and Quiz

Note: Make a habit of studying for 2-3 hours at a stretch.

STEP 3 Refine the Approach and Time Management

- Start timed practice of harder questions for accuracy and time management
- Take another Sectional Mock to gauge improvement
- Create error logs for identifying concepts and sub-types to practice more
- Continue the timed practice of AWA essays from the ETS pool
- Use Jamboree's Vocabulary App for Vocabulary building: Learn, Revise, and Quiz

STEP 4 Build Accuracy

- Develop concept-wise accuracy with Reading Comprehension, Sentence completion, and Critical Reasoning Tests
- Continue Timed Practice of AWA essays
- Use Jamboree's Vocabulary App for Vocabulary building: Learn, Revise, and Quiz

STEP 5 Build Section-wise Accuracy

- Write Verbal Tests to build accuracy for the entire Verbal section
- Write a few AWA tests
- Maintain error logs and Revise concepts based on performance
- Use Jamboree's Vocabulary App to Revise Vocabulary

STEP 6 Full-Length Tests

- Write a few full-length mocks, including AWA, Verbal, and Quant sections
- Maintain error logs and Revise concepts based on performance
- Continue using Jamboree's Vocabulary App to Revise Vocabulary

GRE QUANT STUDY PLAN CHECKLIST



STEP 1 Learn the Basics

- Understand the format and structure of the GRE Quantitative section
- Review fundamental mathematical concepts: arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and data interpretation
- Familiarize yourself with the different types of Quantitative questions
- Explore and practice using essential GRE math formulas
- Utilise GRE prep materials and textbooks for foundational learning

STEP 2 Practice Basic and Intermediate Problems

- Begin with solving easy-level Quantitative problems
- Progress to medium-level problems as you gain confidence
- Focus on specific question types: quantitative comparison, data interpretation, and problem-solving
- Take a Timed Quantitative Test to assess your progress
- Review and understand solutions for incorrect answers

STEP 3 Learn Advanced Concepts

- Dive deeper into advanced mathematical concepts, including algebra, geometry, and probability
- Master techniques for tackling complex Quantitative problems
- Explore advanced GRE math formulas and their applications
- Solve challenging problems to enhance problem-solving skills
- Take a Timed Quantitative Test to gauge improvement

STEP 4 Refine Time Management & Error Analysis

- Practice timed sets of problems to improve time management skills.
- Analyze errors and create an error log to identify weak areas.
- Focus on specific question types or topics where errors are prevalent.
- Take a Sectional Mock Test to assess overall quantitative performance.
- Review and understand solutions for incorrect answers

STEP 5 Build Conceptual Accuracy

- Write comprehensive tests covering a range of quantitative concepts
- Focus on accuracy by reviewing and revisiting challenging topics
- Use a variety of GRE math practice resources to reinforce learning
- Continue refining time management strategies in a timed setting

STEP 6 Full-Length Tests

- Take several full-length GRE practice tests, including all sections (Verbal, Quant, and AWA)
- Analyze performance in each section and maintain an error log
- Review and revise concepts based on test performance
- Continue practising with a focus on time management
- Utilize GRE prep resources for additional practice problems and strategies

GRE ANALYTICAL WRITING STUDY PLAN CHECKLIST



STEP 1 Understand the Task

- Familiarise yourself with the structure of the Analytical Writing section
- Understand the specific requirements of the "Analyze an Issue" task
- Review sample GRE Issue prompts to grasp the range of topics
- Analyse sample essays to identify effective writing strategies

STEP 2 Develop a Template and Structure

- Create a template for organizing your "Analyze an Issue" essay.
- Practice outlining essays with clear introductions, body paragraphs, and conclusions.
- Develop a strategy for addressing both sides of the given issue.
- Work on crafting strong thesis statements that reflect your position on the issue

GRE ANALYTICAL WRITING STUDY PLAN CHECKLIST



STEP 3 Build a Bank of Examples and Ideas

- Compile a list of examples and ideas that can be used to support various positions
- Organize examples based on different categories (historical, scientific, cultural, etc.)
- Practice integrating examples seamlessly into your essay
- Aim for a diverse range of examples to demonstrate flexibility in thinking

STEP 4 Practice Writing Essays

- Begin with untimed practice essays to focus on content and structure
- Gradually move to timed essays to simulate test conditions
- Review and self-assess your essays using GRE rubrics
- Identify areas for improvement, especially in terms of clarity and coherence

STEP 5 Seek Feedback and Review

- Share your essays with peers or mentors for constructive feedback
- Pay attention to feedback on argument strength, organization, and language use
- Revise essays based on feedback and continue practising
- Review sample high-scoring essays to understand successful strategies

STEP 6 Timed Practice and Revision

- Focus on timed practice to improve efficiency and time management
- Identify common errors or weaknesses in your timed essays
- Revise and refine your approach based on timed practice
- Take full-length practice tests, including the Analytical Writing section
